Notice About Security

When you visit the Online Contract Access Website (hereinafter "Website"), you can log onto pages where access is permitted only after you have supplied a valid and authorized User ID and PIN. This information serves to verify your identity, so that only you can access your contract and initiate transactions through the Website.

Michigan Education Trust and Intuition Systems, Inc. are committed to protecting your privacy online. When you log onto secure pages, we use 128-bit SSL certificates for securing information. SSL has been universally accepted on the World Wide Web for authenticated and encrypted communication between clients and servers. In addition, all data that you send to us and we confirm back to you, is sent over an encrypted SSL connection protected with a mechanism for detecting tempering – that is, for automatically determining whether the data has been altered in transit. This basically means that the data sent is encrypted and is designed so it can only be decrypted by our web server. To provide additional protection your data is stored on a secure server behind our firewall. Firewalls can be thought of as a selective barrier that permits only specific types of transactions through to our system. This Website may utilize 'cookies' – small text files placed on your computer hard drive – when you use this site. Cookies may be used for security purposes, to facilitate navigation of the Website, or to personalize your use of the site by retaining preferences. The cookies used by this Website do not contain personally identifiable information, and are used ONLY in the context of your use of this Website.

To use this site you need a browser that supports encryption and dynamic web page construction. It is strongly recommended that you have a secure browser which supports 128 bit encryption.

Each user session is set up for a specific period of time. If you do not make a transaction within that specific period of time, the session times out. If your session times out, and you are not finished using the Website, you will need to log on again. This reduces "the window of opportunity" for an unauthorized user to access your contract information if you walk away from your computer without logging off the Website.

To help ensure the confidentiality and integrity of your information:

- Do not share your Social Security Number, Michigan Education Trust contract number(s), Michigan Education Trust User ID or Password with anyone.

If you provide personal information to effect a transaction, only a record of the transaction performed while on the Website is retained by Michigan Education Trust's secure system, maintained by Intuition Systems, Inc.

Personal information provided to Michigan Education Trust via Intuition System, Inc.'s Website is not sold or bartered. In addition, the personal information provided through this web is not revealed to any person or organization outside of Michigan Education Trust unless:

- Proper authorization or direction from you to do so has been received,
- It is required by law, or
- It is necessary to do so in order to enable service providers to perform work on behalf of the Program.
